- Answers questions from the public about Pleasure Craft Licensing and the Pleasure Craft Operator Card
- Assists local governments and first nations communities with proposals for Vessel Operation Restrictions
- Conducts Canada Shipping Act, 2001 training with enforcement partners
- Runs training sessions for Pleasure Craft Courtesy Check partners
- Distributes materials to rental agencies and conducts oversight checks.
- Provide funding opportunities through the Boating Safety Contribution
