

# Don't Pick Up Hitchhikers: Play Clean Go!

## Hitchhiker Tally Sheet

### Instructions

- Write your name and the date of your excursion
- Fill out a separate table for each location that you visited. Describe the location such as where it is, any notable habitats or dominant activities.
- Sort collected items into groups that are the same. Name them (such as Spiky seed A, Spiky Seed B, Parachute Seed, Inchworm, and so on.)
- Look closely and describe what you see in detail so that you could identify and recognize it again.
- Count how many individuals you found of each item.
- Add sketches or try to identify what you found.
- If you take a photo, put the name of the item on a piece of paper in the photo (such as Spiky seed A) so that you can match your description with the photo.

### Sample Entry

Example: Sticky seed A	18	Seeds are 5-6 mm long and 2.5 mm wide, brown and hooked at the tip, clustered around a round, ball-shaped fruit.	They covered my socks. Looks like burdock in the field guide. Took photos with label "Sticky seed A".
