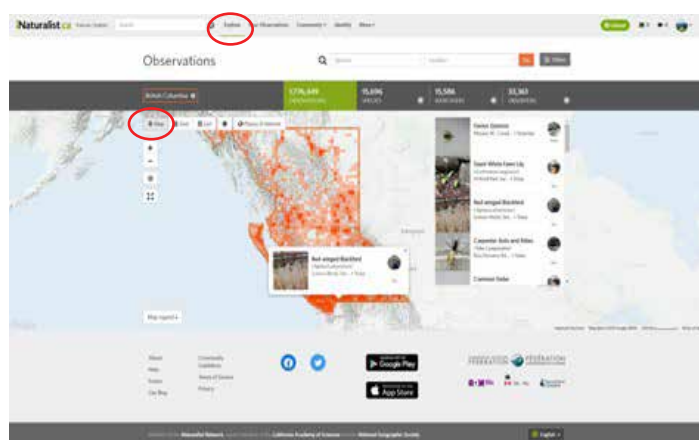


How to Create a GIF Invasive Rabbits

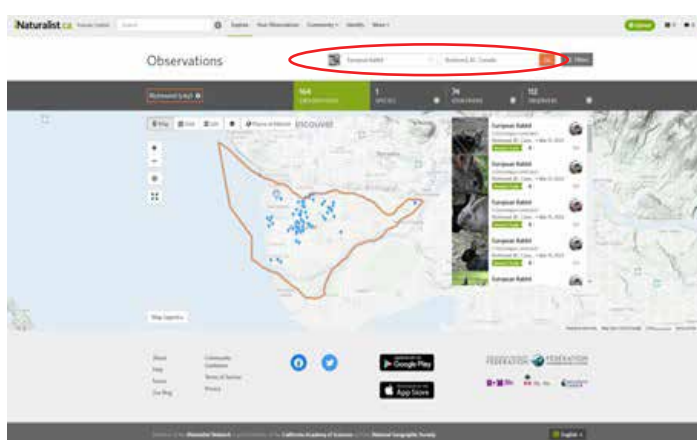
Step one

- Go to [iNaturalist.ca](https://www.inaturalist.ca) and select “Explore” from the top menu bar.
- Select “Map” to view observations on the map if this view does not show initially.



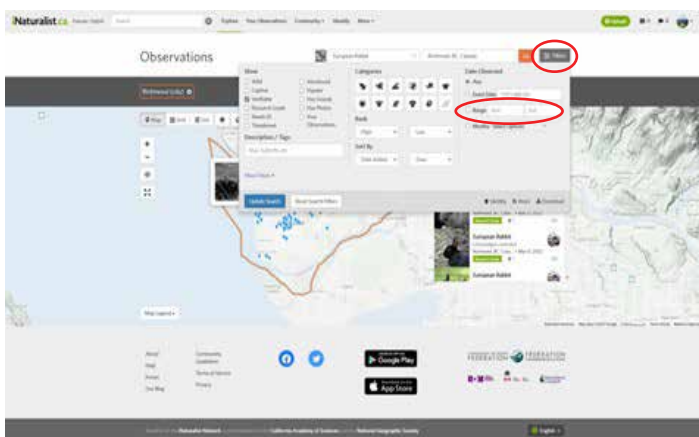
Step two

- Using the “Observations” search bar, search for “European Rabbits”
- Using the “Location” search bar, filter the results by specifying “Richmond, BC”



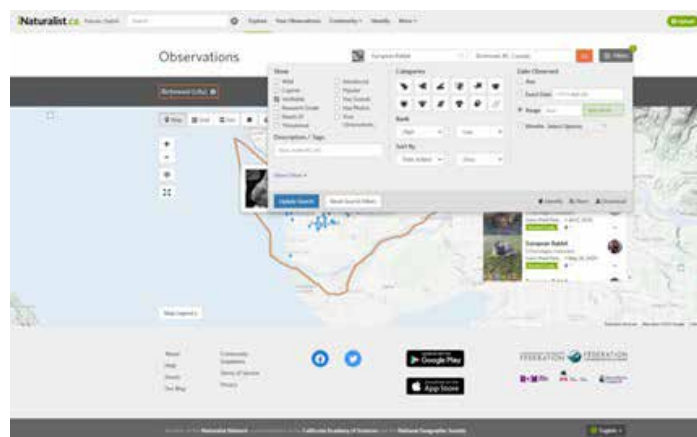
Step three

- Click on the “Filter” tab and filter observations by date observed. Use “Range” and change the end date. Start with the current date.



Step four

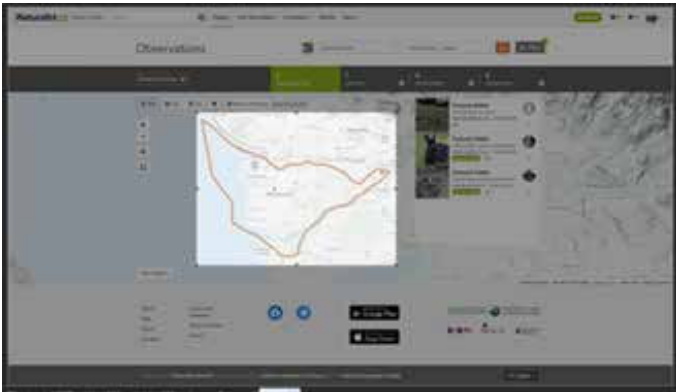
- Take a screenshot before changing the end date to one year previous. Continue this process until you have gone as far as you would like to go. For this example, we took screenshots from 2018 to 2022.

Step five

- Edit your screenshots to add any text or icons and crop the image to your desired size. For this example, the GIF creator website also added the text and cropped the image.



Step six

- Adjust the timing of the frames to match the desired pacing, save and download the GIF!
